A.10 SAIL NUMBERS

A.10.2 In the United States of America, sail numbers shall be issued by US Windsurfing. <http://www.uswindsurfing.org>

C.7 SAILS

C.7.2 SAIL NUMBERS

- (a) Per Rule G1.1(c), An owner may be allotted a personal sail number by US Windsurfing, which may be used on all his boards.
- (b) Rule 77 is amended as follows:
 - (i) National identification is not required.
 - (ii) When the sail is of clear material, the numbers may be placed on the starboard side only. Numbers must be clearly visible, in a solid contrasting color and identifiable from both sides of the sail.
 - (iii) All characters must be displayed horizontally and not in a column.
 - (iv) A competitor may not be disqualified for infringing the provisions of this rule without prior warning and adequate opportunity to make correction.
 - (v) Any exception to this rule must be approved by the US Windsurfing Executive Board.
